BRONZE Key Stage 1

Essential Me

- Show acts of kindness to children in your class
- Be ready for learning e.g. listen and follow instructions
- Show independence in class e.g. ask a friend
- Practise and improve something to help your learning e.g. number bonds to ten
- Share your learning with another child
- Be recognised in our Jigsaw assembly celebration
- Consistently show school values
- Notice something in your environment that inspires you and explain why

Enthusiastic Me

- Get a postcard home from your teacher
- Get a phone call home from your teacher
- Earn 30 class dojos for effort in a term
- Earn a sticker for good work from your teacher

- Consistently read 3 times a week at home
- Be chosen for Hot Chocolate with the Head
- Earn a Headteacher Award
- Complete a reading challenge e.g. in school or at your local library

Courageous Me

- Show your learning at the board
- Ask another member of staff a question when moving around the school
- Take on a challenge at Forest School
- Perform something in class – recite a poem/story, PE sequence, dance routine, homework task
- Regularly take turns
- Try a new fruit or vegetable
- Take up a teacher challenge
- Join a Play Leader activity at lunchtimes

Responsible Me

- Help others by taking responsibility for a class job
- Show pride in your workbooks
- Invite and include younger children to join in a game at lunch time
- Bring in a WOW from home
- Make a home for mini beasts
- Write a prayer and read it to your class
- Know your birthday, full name and address
- Bring your reading record and reading book every day

SILVER Key Stage 2

Essential Me

- Show acts of kindness to children in a different class
- Be ready for learning at the start of lessons
- Show independence by thinking for yourself to complete work
- Practise until you have learnt a new skill e.g. climb a tree
- Be recognised in our Jigsaw assembly celebration more than once
- Consistently show school values
- Contribute a Big Question to a class collective worship activity

Enthusiastic Me

- Get two postcards home from your teacher
- Get two phone calls home from your teacher
- Earn 40 class dojos for effort in a term
- Finish a book and recommend it to someone who would enjoy it in school
- Be chosen for Hot Chocolate with the Head
- Earn 2 Headteacher Awards over the year

- Complete a reading challenge e.g. in school or at your local library

Courageous Me

- Join a school club in the school day
- Join a school competition e.g. library competition, poster competition
- Perform something in class – recite a poem/story, PE sequence, dance routine,
- Go on a one-night residential
- Share an achievement in assembly
- Try a new challenge set by your teacher

Responsible Me

- Help others by taking responsibility for a class job
- Represent your class on the School Council
- Tell your class how you would like to improve something at school e.g. playtimes, the environment, school lunches
- Write a prayer and read it in assembly
- Make an item to sell at the Christmas Fayre
- Collect litter for 5 lunchtimes
- Manage the bird feeders

GOLD Key Stage 2

Essential Me

- Show kindness in school and at home
- Come prepared to learn for a whole week
- Show initiative in your learning
- Practise until you have learnt a new skill e.g. djembe drumming, light a fire
- Be recognised in our Jigsaw assembly celebration each term
- Consistently show the school values
- Train to be a Class Collective Worship Leader

Enthusiastic Me

- Get a postcard home from another adult
- Get a phone call home from another adult
- Earn your 25m swimming certificate
- Finish a book and write a book review
- Be chosen for Hot Chocolate with the Head twice
- Earn 4 Headteacher Awards over the year

- Complete a reading challenge e.g. in school or at your local library

Courageous Me

- Join an after-school club
- Compete for the school in another event - maths challenge, science challenge
- Play your instrument in a celebration assembly
- Enter a national/local competition e.g. 500 words story writing
- Compete for your school in an event e.g. netball match or other sporting event
- Go on a school residential
- Share an achievement in assembly

Responsible Me

- Help others by taking on a school job e.g. join the Eco Team, be a Librarian
- Research something you want to change in the community and present in assembly.
- Take on a school role e.g. School Councillor, Sports Leader
- Present in assembly
- Support a charity and raise some money
- Show responsibility for the school environment e.g. regularly pick up litter, weed and water flower beds, refill bird feeders

PLATINUM Key Stage 2

Essential Me

- Show an act of kindness to someone in the community
- Always be prepared for your school day
- Set yourself a learning target and show how you have worked to complete it.
- Practise until you have learnt a new skill – e.g. first aid, cycling proficiency level 1 and 2, abseiling
- Use your expertise to support other classes
- Consistently show school values
- Plan, run and evaluate a spiritual and wellbeing event

Enthusiastic Me

- Get a postcard home from two different adults
- Get a phone call home from two different adults
- Your best work gets published on website/newsletter/Hanney News
- Earn your 25m swimming certificate
- Run a book recommendation group in the library

- Earn 6 Headteacher Awards – one per short term
- Complete a reading challenge e.g. in school or at your local library

Courageous Me

- Join a club outside of school
- Take part in a VAT event e.g. Minispeaks, VAT choir, VAT Olympics, Singing Festival
- Try something new which you were apprehensive about
- Compete for your school in more than one sports event e.g. netball match and athletics competition
- Be shortlisted to take part in the VAT Easter Music Concert
- Go on a residential trip and agree a personal challenge with your teacher

Responsible Me

- Help others e.g. become a Peer Mentor, Reading Buddy
- Try leadership e.g. Sports Leader, Collective Worship Ambassador
- Represent your school on the VAT Pupil Parliament
- Raise money for a charity that you care about
- Write something for the school newsletter or Hanney News
- Lead a campaign to reduce plastic waste or litter in the community
