With our curriculum driver of **EMPATHY** this term, linked to our values of community and kindness, we have had a week thinking of others.

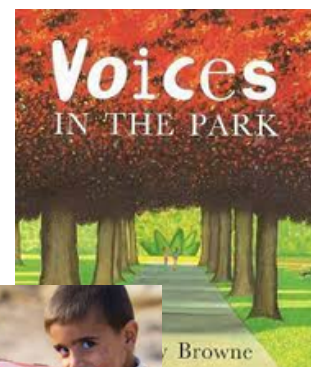
In Collective Worship we thought about seeing things from other people's point of view, using the Anthony Browne book 'Voices in the park'.

Sleep:

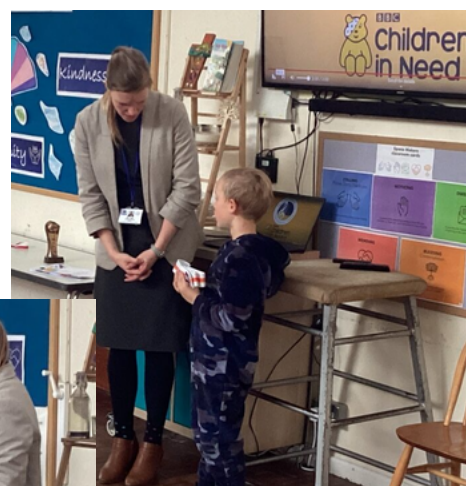
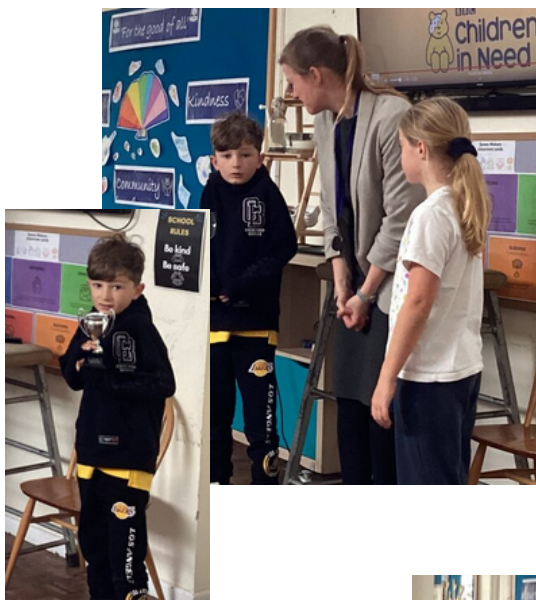
This can be so challenging for so many of us. Please arrange to speak to Mrs Richardson, our Home School Link Worker if this is something you feel your family would benefit from help with.



At any given time up to 40% of adults and 50% of children (this rises to 80% with a SEND diagnosis) have difficulties with their sleep. Yet in a recent survey, almost 60% of adults felt there was a lack of support for sleep issues. Sleep problems can leave people feeling isolated and lonely. Our free helpline is run by trained sleep advisors, many of whom are specialists in working with SEND. We can talk to young people directly, or parents.
