Item/project	Cost	Objectives
CPD	£3500	This includes: VAT CPD package that includes ½ day a week teaching support to improve the skills of staff to enable them to deliver high quality PE.
PE Equipment	£300	To ensure there is the appropriate equipment of a good quality to deliver high quality PE lessons.
Access to After school sports clubs	£150	To ensure access to After School Sports Clubs is available to all students.
St James Leaders T shirts	£50	To encourage students to run After School Clubs for younger children and therefore developing leadership skills
Emotional Literacy Support Assistant (ELSA)	£1000	Qualification for an existing member of staff to be able to support children with SEMH issues
